Buloke Library Services Review Update

Buloke Shire Council is currently undertaking a review of its library services. The aim of this project is to undertake a detailed review of Council's current library services, and recommend the best service delivery model, including key improvements to be undertaken within the resources available to the Council.

"Council recognises the importance of its library service for many residents and as part of the review is inviting residents to take part in a simple yet integral survey with the opportunity to also make general submissions", said Mayor, Cr Reid Mather.

"This current review of library services is part of a rolling program of all Council's services. Growing financial pressures in the local government sector necessitates constant review of our services to ensure we balance residents demand for services with our community's capacity to pay for them through rates. Council is committed to consulting with the community before considering any changes to the service", Cr Mather said.

Council is seeking the views and opinions from both current users of the library service and the wider community. Even if you do not currently use the library service you may wish to be involved and express an opinion on the provision of the service. The survey is for residents of Buloke Shire.
