Successful grants for sporting facilities

Two local sports and recreation facilities will be getting upgrades after the success of grant applications was recently announced. A total of \$116,469 will be provided by the Andrews Government for upgrading the Nullawil Netball Change Room and redeveloping the Wycheproof Tennis Courts. These grants are part of the \$100 million 2016-17 Community Sports Infrastructure Fund.

In Nullawil, the Netball Change Room Upgrade will upgrade the existing building to include separate change facilities for officials and players, a new family/disabled change area and toilet facilities. The project will provide the Nullawil Netball Club and the Nullawil Tennis Club with dedicated change facilities and associated amenities to appropriately cater for female participants.

The Wycheproof Tennis Court Redevelopment Project will provide for the reconstruction of two synthetic all weather tennis courts. It will improve the quality of the courts for the existing users through the reduction of trip hazards and reconstruction of the court base. The synthetic surface will be line-marked for tennis and hockey.

"The investment in our local sporting facilities is a great result for Buloke. Buloke is a sporting region that deserves quality facilities. These upgrades will make sport in the region more accessible and provide these townships with great facilities to enjoy", said Mayor, Cr Reid Mather.
